# COVID-19 and the Variants

Delta Variant is now predominant strain in United States

- It is 225% more infectious than original strain
- The time to be detectable is 4 days rather than 6
- More than 99% of deaths are in unvaccinated individuals
- The symptoms are a little different:
  - Headache, fever, runny nose
  - Cough not as prominent
  - Loss of taste or smell not as likely
