All licensees need to complete 3 hours of AMA category 1 CME on opioid prescribing every 2 years. The CME must be taken since your last renewal in order to be counted towards this requirement.

Buprenorphine Waiver training as described by the Substance Abuse and Mental Health Services Administration (SAMSHA) may be counted toward meeting the requirement of this law as long as the training is approved Category 1 Continuing Medical Education by the American Medical Association Council on Medical Education (AMA).

The Maine Medical Education Trust designates this live activity for a maximum of 3 AMA PRA Category 1 Credits™. Physicians should only claim credit commensurate with the extent of their participation in the activity.
