The Advanced Trauma Life Support® program teaches a systematic and concise approach to the care of the trauma patient by providing a safe and reliable method for immediate evaluation and treatment. The program focuses on treating the greatest threat in life first. It demonstrates how to assess a patient's condition, resuscitate and stabilize the patient, and determine if his or her needs exceed a facility's capacity. The program also addresses arranging a patient's inter-hospital transfer to ensure that optimum care is provided. ATLS training provides a common language that can save lives.
