Many health insurance plans support a PCP change while away from home, and we encourage you to review your health plan's out-of-network benefits prior to the student's arrival in the fall.

Why switch to a Cutler Health Center provider?

- Continuity of Care Students are on campus for nine or more months out of the year.
- Referring for specialty care Your PCP coordinates referrals if you need specialty care. Through Cutler Health Center's partnership with Northern Light Eastern Maine Medical Center, you can be referred to a local specialist with a quick turnaround time. We even share the same Electronic Medical Record (EMR) system.
- Lower out-of-pocket costs With a local PCP, you will most likely just need to cover a small co-pay for any care you receive rather than obtaining a referral for each visit or deal with the inconvenience of insurance denials.
